



We are pleased to provide the following wording when making a gift to Brunswick Street Mission in your will. You can print this document for your files saving it for the right moment or to send to your lawyer.

- **A general bequest designates a certain dollar amount to Brunswick Street Mission.**

Example: "I give to Brunswick Street Mission, located at 2107 Brunswick Street Halifax NS, Canada, with charitable registration number 81665 9320 RR0001, the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_."

- **A specific bequest directs that Brunswick Street Mission is to receive a specified piece of property.**

Example: "I give to Brunswick Street Mission, located at 2107 Brunswick Street Halifax NS, Canada [insert number] shares of ABC stock."

- **A residual bequest designates Brunswick Street Mission to receive all, or a portion of, whatever remains after all debts, taxes, expenses and other bequests have been paid.**

Example: "I give to Brunswick Street Mission, located at 2107 Brunswick Street Halifax NS, Canada [insert percentage] percent ( \_\_%) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate."

- **A contingent bequest takes effect only under certain conditions.**

Example: "In the event my wife/husband/partner does not survive me, I give to Brunswick Street Mission, located at 2107 Brunswick Street Halifax NS, Canada, the sum of . . ."
