- 1. All paddlers receive dry land training before moving onto the water.
- 2. Coaches will be in each boat, whether a six-man or dragon boat.
- Pack a change of clothes; you're sure to get at least a little bit wet.
- Dress for the day. The rule? Layers. Layers. Layers. Bring flip flops or gumboots for the boat.
