Please note: We may already have some of the documents outlined below on file. The NSRDHDTD staff will work with you to ensure you have accurate information regarding the documentation required to complete your application. **The application must be submitted once started and cannot be saved.**

I have been informed that the NSRDHDTD has the following documents on file:	
	A photocopy of my birth certificate
	Evidence of name change, if my current name differs from that on my birth certificate and/or transcript e.g., driver's licence, passport, marriage licence, or other government-issued ID
	A passport-like picture (full facial profile) in a format appropriate for a regulator e.g., business casual clothing
	Evidence of successful completion of the NS Jurisprudence Examination offered through the NSRDHDTD, which can only be taken <u>after an application for reinstatement is received</u> . The cost to take the online exam is \$50. Once the fee is deposited into our account, you will be provided with a link to complete the exam.
	My employment visa or permanent resident card under Canadian Immigration Act (non-Canadian citizens only)
	Copy of any English language proficiency tests completed (Mother tongue other than English and/or Denturism program delivered in a language other than English). See the English Language Requirements .
	Successful completion of the written and OSCE (Objectively Structured Clinical Examination) denturist qualifying or registration examination approved by the NSRDHDTD e.g., the examinations administered through the College of Denturists of Ontario, College of Alberta Denturists, and British Columbia.
	My official transcript with proof of graduation from a denturist program. Please indicate if it was accredited at the time of graduation. If your program has not been previously reviewed, a full review will be required.
I have uploaded the following supporting documents (upload within the Reinstatement Application). Note: The CPR and PLI documents are mandatory to upload with your first application submission; however, if you don't upload the remaining documents with your first submission, you will have an opportunity to upload them later, following our review.	
	Proof of professional liability insurance (PLI) that meets the requirements e.g., through the Denturist Society of NS or another liability insurance that meets the requirements)
	A copy of my current permanent CPR certificate, at the level required by the Board, taken within the last 12 months (typically called BLS or HCP). The level of CPR certification must include, at a minimum, classroom instruction and practicum experience related to: - one & two-person rescuer chest compressions for adults, children and infants; - one & two-person rescuer adult, child & infant bag-valve-mask technique & rescue breathing; - relief of choking in adults, children & infants; and - use of an automated external defibrillator (AED).
	Evidence of 36 hours of continuing denturism education <u>within the most recent three years</u> . Please enter your Continuing Education courses (with supporting documentation) online through your NSRDHDTD Portal. <i>(Does not apply to applicants who graduated within the last 36 months).</i>
	Evidence that I have practiced <u>600 hours</u> of denturism in the 3 years immediately before the date of my application <i>(does not apply to applicants who graduated within the last 36 months)</i> . If applicable, this must be in the form of a signed letter from the employer (on letterhead), ROE (Record of Employment), or another acceptable alternative document if you were the business owner, as determined by the Registrar.
	A current passport-type picture, if requested by NSRDHDTD (required if your photo on file is over 3 years)

	Verification Forms: I have completed Part A of the NSRDHDTD Verification Form for Other Regulatory Bodies and sent the form to each jurisdiction that I am currently (or was previously) certified, licensed, or registered as a denturist or another regulated profession. <i>I have requested each jurisdiction to send the completed form directly to the NSRDHDTD.</i>
I require additional documentation:	
	I am applying to have my Dentures Over Implants competency recognized. Therefore, I have: completed the relevant application form (linked within the general application and then sent to info@oralhealthns.ca once filled out) and provided any required documentation, if applicable. Note: This additional practice competency is not mandatory to obtain a practising licence in NS, but you cannot provide denture over implant services unless you are authorized by the NSRDHDTD.

I have paid the required fees by certified cheque, money order, e-transfer or credit card: (Note: Invoices will be generated for you. Further payment details will be provided in the invoice.)

\$135.00 Application fee (separate) & non-refundable – must be sent before the application will be reviewed
Note: For all new applications, this fee is waived for applicants if you (1) hold a current unrestricted (full), practising licence in a Canadian Jurisdiction, and (2) you are in good standing with that jurisdiction.

\$160.00 Registration fee – See note under Application fee. This fee is waived if you meet the same criteria.

\$500.00 Reinstatement fee – You will be advised if you owe a reinstatement fee.

\$1000.00 Licence fee (Nov 1, 2025 to Oct 31, 2026)
