Presentation Summary: An overview of community water fluoridation (CWF), including the health and equity benefits of this population intervention, and the impacts and costs of ceasing versus maintaining CWF.

The New Regulatory Framework for the NSRDHDTD

Presentation Summary: The dental hygiene, dental technology, and denturism professions in Nova Scotia recently achieved a significant milestone, as the Regulators for each of these professions migrated to the new Regulated Health Professions Act (RHPA). The RHPA modernizes professional self-regulation and enables the professions to efficiently and effectively serve the public interest. During this brief presentation, one of the NSRDHDRD's lawyers, Ryan Baxter, will discuss some of these notable changes.
