	A photocopy of my birth certificate (if not in English or French, please provide a translation)
	Evidence of name change, if your current name differs from that on your birth certificate and/or transcript e.g., driver's licence, passport, marriage licence, or other government issued ID.
	Proof of professional liability insurance (PLI) that meets the <u>requirements</u> (e.g., CDHA insurance or another liability insurance that meets the <u>requirements</u>)
	 A copy of my current permanent CPR certificate, at the level required by Council taken within the last 12 months (typically called BLS <i>or</i> HCP). The level of CPR certification must include, at a minimum, classroom instruction and practicum experience related to: one and two-person rescuer chest compressions for adults, children and infants; one and two-person rescuer adult, child and infant bag-valve mask technique and rescue breathing; relief of choking in adults, children, and infants; and use of an automated external defibrillator (AED).
	A passport-type sized photo (full facial profile) in a format appropriate for a regulator e.g., business casual clothing. Note : This does NOT have to be an actual passport photo. This gives you an example of the size of image and that it should be a full facial profile (head and shoulders). You may smile in your photo.
	Evidence of successful completion of the NS Jurisprudence course <i>OR</i> the NS Self-Initiation Course*. Both are offered through the <u>CDHA</u> . Please note: Completion of the Self-Initiation (SI) NS Course, rather than the Jurisprudence Exam is strongly recommended. You do NOT have to complete both courses. The SI <u>NS</u> course contains the Jurisprudence component as part of the modules within that course.

Therefore, I have: Completed the relevant online application form (links are within the general application), and provided any required documentation – <u>Note</u> : These procedures are not mandatory to obtain a practising licence in NS, but you cannot perform them unless you are authorized by the CDHNS.
