



## Standing Committee Terms of Reference

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### 1.0 General Purpose

The Whitewater Committee manages the development of whitewater paddling within the Participation and Technical Development Pathways.

### 1.1 Committee Composition

The committee shall have up to four members, plus any assigned staff:

- Director Whitewater, who shall chair the committee
- Up to three other members
- Technical staff as may be assigned to the committee

### 1.2 Terms of Committee Membership

- The Director Whitewater will chair the committee for the duration of their term of office
- Other committee members are named to the committee to the second CKBC AGM following their appointment
- Staff members shall serve on the committee while holding their staff position

### 1.3 Scope of Responsibility

The committee is responsible for:

- Establishment of whitewater development activities in accordance with the approved Strategic and Operational Plans, including competitions and clinics
- Biannual review of the CKC Whitewater Racing rules for proposed changes, with follow-up recommendations to clubs for ratification
- Work with all technical committees and Member Clubs to establish the annual competitive calendar
- Work with Member Clubs to assist as appropriate with their local whitewater initiatives
- Oversee the work of the Whitewater Coaching and Officiating sub-committees

### 1.4 Accountability and Authority

- The committee is accountable to the Board of Directors through the Director Whitewater.
- The committee has the authority to undertake activities based on approved Strategic and Operational Plans and approved budgets.
- The committee shall provide a written report to the AGM each year.

### 1.5 Meetings

The committee will meet at least three times per year in person or electronically.
