Commitments in CLE-GASHA Agreement

- CLE project provided:
 - classroom training through MoreOB on *, **, *** ,
 - classroom training via CREW on <, <<, <<<
 - regular observations on interactions among team members at weekly meetings



Commitments in CLE-GASHA Agreement

- **GASHA completed the following:**
 - **shared a description of client population, and population level data related to obstetrical services at St Martha's facilities;**
 - **shared a description of current & potential teaming in delivery of care;**
 - **shared information on define barriers and enablers to teaming;**
 - **identified Management level champion for teamwork;**
 - **identified meeting and training space(s) for team;**
 - **provided access to its ethics review process; and**
 - **facilitated data collection.**

Data supplied by GASHA about patient-provider interaction

- **Data for midwives and obstetricians from October 2010 to February 2011:**
 - 1,484 patients**
 - 149 midwife-obstetrician led clinics**
- **No data for patient interaction with RNs, public health nurses, dieticians, lactation consultant, social worker**
- **No information on patient outcomes**
- **No information on patients' or providers' satisfaction**



Commitments in CLE-GASHA Agreement

- **Clinicians:**
 - # attended each MoreOB training sessions (# FP, # MW, # OB, # RN, # other providers)
 - # participate in each CREW program session (# FP, # MW, # OB, # RN, # other providers)
 - # attend each weekly team meeting
 - # weekly team meetings that include:
 - collective planning of patient care
 - collective review of patient files
 - reflection



Where Do We Go Next ?

- **Patient engagement (satisfaction and perspectives on care)**
- **Collective development by clinicians of protocols & team policies**
- **Data collection on patients' interaction with all providers on team**
- **Leadership / championing to share learning and teaming experience with others**
