What is the CLE?

- Funded by Health Canada AACHHR Project
- A model to provide well woman, low-risk obstetrical community based shared-care to women and their families.
- Achieved by linking the unique skills and collaborative efforts of practitioners

Health Canada's definition

Collaborative patient-centred practice is designed to promote the active participation of each discipline in providing quality patient care. It enhances patient and family-centred goals and values, provides mechanisms for continuous communication among care givers, optimizes staff participation in clinical decision making (within and across disciplines), and fosters respect for the contributions of all disciplines."

The Sites

□ As of December 2010 there are four identified sites:

- **GASHA in Antigonish, NS**
- Labrador West Health Region NL
- VON Well Baby and Me in Miramichi City and Sussex

Agreement with Sites

Partnership Agreements (PAs)

- The GASHA site is complete;
- the NL site PA is drafted
- PA for VON NB is complete
- All sites have identified clinical leads and site champions have been identified.

- Approach for this site may be less program centric and more community centric.

GASHA site

□ MOReOB

- front end change approach to IP rather than the end approach to IP that MoreOb has traditionally taken.
- Attended a Moncton Module 1 workshop
- Presentation of results on Dec 17
- Module 2 on Jan 25, 2011.

GASHA con't

□ IP and Clinical Services

- Forms have been developed and integrated into the GASHA charts
- All charts will be coded for purpose of data collection

Labrador City West

- □ Home Care and Emergency Services
- □ Collaborative team

KTE and Government Advisory

- New Government Advisory group set up in NL
- NL Nurses Association has requested a presentation pending
- Reports to Health Canada and visit to NS on November 2
- Pending funding

Evaluation

- Ethics Approval for GAHSA and Labrador
 City granted-not required for VON, NB sites;
- Needs assessment data collection has been competed at all sites;
- Contextual and Implementation Process Data collection from all sites underway & ongoing
