Report to the Board of Directors, meeting in Ottawa on April 25, 2024:

Further to my last oral report providing an overall breakdown of the revenues and expenses incurred, and representing that all expected revenues have been collected and liabilities satisfied, except:

1. Revenue Quebec has assessed our summary report on GST / PST and has decided that it owes the company some \$3,900, which it will keep pending the filing and assessment of all tax returns due;
2. Tax returns for 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022 have been prepared; they all show no activity of the company; Tax returns for 2023 have been prepared; due to the small business deduction, I don't believe any tax will be payable;
3. The plan is once Revenue Quebec/ Canada are satisfied that all tax liabilities have been met, it will be the recommendation of the Committee that the Company be authorized to forward to the Association any and all remaining funds, to close the bank account and to file a Articles of Dissolution of the Company.
