Bills of Lading vs Sea Waybills – and of course the Himalaya Clause

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Types of Sea Waybills and Bills of Lading

- 1. Sea Waybill not negotiable
- 2. Straight Bills of Lading not negotiable
- 3. To Order Bills of Lading negotiable
- 4. Bearer Bills of Lading negotiable



With whom is the Shipping Line contracting

1. Bills of Lading

- Need to tender the document for possession of cargo
- Application of the Bills of Lading Act
- Issued in three originals

2. Sea Waybills

- No need to tender the document for possession
- Often issued only electronically
- Bills of Lading Act does not apply



Documents of Title

1. Sea Waybills

No issue - not a document of title

2. Bills of Lading

- History of the term "document of title"
- Bills of Lading Act
- Hague Visby Rules

• 3. Entitlement to Possession



Himalaya Clause

• 1. History

2. Modern three prongs of the clause

- Extends benefits of contract of carriage to agent and sub-contractors of the Carrier
- Prohibition of Suit against agents and sub-contractors
- Circular Indemnity Clause
