

## Groups and Guilds

For a Group or Guild to apply to become a juried member, the following criteria must be met:

- One of the Group/Guild members must be a current Juried Status or Master Artisan member of the Craft NS. This member will be the representative of the Group/Guild to the Craft NS.
- The Group/Guild representative will be responsible for ensuring the quality of the Group's or Guild's work adheres to Craft NS's standards.
- The Group/Guild will submit a sampling of their work for assessment by the Craft NS Standards Committee. Once the Guild's or Group's work has been accepted by the Craft NS it will be the responsibility of the Group/Guild representative to ensure that all works sold at Craft NS retail craft shows are up to the same standard as those submitted for assessment. The Craft NS Standards Committee conducts a market review prior to each retail craft market and if, in their opinion, they feel that any works are not up to standard, they have the authority to remove those works from the booth
