Message from Robin Laird, Council Chair

They have also been updating policies and doing site visits across the province to answer questions on the RHPA. They are to be commended on their dedication and attention to detail.

The Council has met and approved revisions to our regulations as well as policy updates. We have also welcomed new public representatives: Shirley Urquhart and Lisa MacDougall.

At a national level, I attended my first CNA Board meeting as the PEI jurisdictional Representative in November. Some of the key messages from this meeting included:
