Dr. Debbie Martin is a Tier II Canada Research Chair in Indigenous Peoples' Health and Well-Being. She leads two large multi-year network grants: the Wabanaki-Labrador Indigenous Health Research Network, and the Atlantic Indigenous Mentorship Network. Both networks offer funding, mentorship and research supports to Indigenous peoples and communities within the Atlantic region.

Debbie is Chair of the Institute of Indigenous Peoples' Health Advisory Board at the Canadian Institutes for Health Research and is a newly elected member of the Royal Society of Canada College of New Scholars. She is Inuk and a member of NunatuKavut, and also mom to two amazing but noisy kids, 10-year-old Marty and Anna-Rose, age 6.
