Dalhousie Faculty Association asks for conciliation

HALIFAX, NS – The Dalhousie Faculty Association (DFA) President Anthony Stewart said the DFA has called for the services of a conciliator to advance stalled negotiations with the Dalhousie University Board of Governors.

“We have been at the table for more than 40 hours, and we have made almost no progress despite our best efforts,” said Stewart. “We think a conciliator will move us beyond this impasse and help us come to satisfactory collective agreement.”

The last contract for the approximately 870 faculty, instructors, librarians and counsellors expired June 30, 2011, although negotiations began April 1, 2011.
