Dear Family and Friends;

Well, time is flying by faster than I can imagine. We have been here for 8 months now, so just wanted to give you our progress report for the last couple months. We have had our ups and downs, but God is faithful. We have been talking about doing evangelism and things have finally opened up from Covid. We are starting to do services outside people's homes and the youth are going to be going to the park to sing. One of the youth will share something. We are also going to be starting the door to door Evangelism and organizing outreach to the communities around us.

We continue to spend time with the different groups i.e. Drug dealers, drug users, and the LGBTQ community. We joke and laugh with them and call them men and women of God. They accept it because we treat them as individuals and show them Gods love by the way we talk to them. We treat them differently than other people in town. They know where we stand with their life choices. We are looking forward to when these words take root in each of their lives and they sell out for God. We are living in a place where God has brought these different groups into our path so we can be the light in the darkness.

We are working with our youth to get them comfortable sharing Gods love with others i.e. evangelism. Jullyanne, Danniel and Dyllann have been making a difference at the parks they hang out in. We have heard back from people who are amazed at the way they treat everyone in the park. Jullyanne has all the kids around her and they love her. She listens to them and has even gone to their events to watch them. They feel special because she takes time for them.

The family has been good, but we have gone through times of missing things from Canada; but this is normal because we are climatizing to the culture and the climate. Yes, the culture, because as a family we have lived in Canada more than we have lived in Brazil. The boys did go

through Dengue fever at the end of April. We did have to take the to hospital with high fevers. In Brazil we don't play with fevers because it is hard to get away from the heat. They got through the fevers and they are on the mend, working on getting their strength back. They want to gaining back a little of the weight they lost because of the virus.

Please pray for Jeanne and Jullyanne as they work at getting an English school up and running, to get more income to support the family. We are also believing for speakers, mics, and cabling for street ministry. We are believing for our car to be paid off so that money can go towards ministry. At some point we are going to be do some fundraisers. Pray for Gods wisdom on how to do this. Please pray that my mind would be able to twist the words to the way they are to come out of my mouth i.e. speaking in Portuguese. I know a lot of words. I just can't seem to put it all together when I need it. Pray for the boys and their school, as it has been rough doing school not only from home but in another country. We as a family can never have too much prayer as we have been going through some challenges. The most important thing is left for the last. Please pray for the groups I have talked about, that the walls will come down and we can see lives changed, and transformed for God, by the power of His love.
