\$100/tonne Premium Spruce Log “PSL”

Length 8’ 4”(100”), 9’0”(108”) Dia. 6”+ top

Load must contain diameters ranging from 6” top to a max. 13” butt to qualify for spruce bonus & be pre-arranged with either Rob or Shawn

\$90/tonne Spruce/Fir Mix

Length 8’ 4” (100”), 9’0” (108”) Diameter 4”+ top max. 13” butt diameter

Plus Long Distance Bonus:

Zone 2 \$3/tonne extra: Pictou, Antigonish, Guysborough, Queens, Annapolis, Cumberland & part of Colchester Counties

Zone 3 \$6/tonne extra: Digby, Shelburne, Yarmouth Counties & Cape Breton Counties

PEI \$14/tonne extra

When delivering wood to Ledwidge Lumber, we ask that the trucker be able to fill out the following information:

1. The vendor receiving payment for product delivered.
2. Town, County, PID no. from where product is being delivered.
3. If a trucking company is being paid by Ledwidge Lumber the company name and rate per tonne is required.
4. Landowner’s Name and Land type (private or crown).

If using a Load Delivery Log Book you can leave a copy of the delivery slip and enter the ticket number.

Quality

- Wood must be fresh & well cut
- Trim butt flare
- No crooked or knotty wood
- No dead or insect damaged wood
- No stain, rot
- No forks or boxy wood
- No white or red pine, hemlock, juniper, or Norway spruce

All loads are reviewed by a licensed scaler to determine wood quality and species. Loads below spec/grade may have deductions applied or may not be accepted.
