Job Title:	Boiler/Kiln Operator
Reports To:	Chief Boiler Operator

Job Purpose

 The Boiler/Kiln Operator is responsible for operating and maintaining the boiler, dry kilns, facility alarm system and sprinkler system. The Operator is also responsible for performing quality control of lumber before and during drying periods.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate and maintain the boiler and kilns
- Perform quality control of lumber before and during drying periods
- Perform daily checks on lumber quality and moisture content at the Planer Mills, this information must be recorded and shared with other Boiler/Kiln Operators
- Monitor fire detection/sprinkler system and alarm system of entire plant
- Perform maintenance and inspection of plant equipment
- Operate loaders when necessary
- Maintain a daily log of operations
- Follow all lock-out procedures when necessary
- Maintain boiler water chemical levels following recommended guidelines
- Ensure his/her workplace has no safety hazards
- Report any hazardous or unsafe working conditions to the Superintendent or nearest Safety Committee Representative
- Adhere to company policies as outlined in the Policy Manual

- 1-2 years experience in industry setting performing similar tasks
- Heavy equipment operation experience
- WHIMIS/OH&S Training

Working Conditions

Must be able to work alone for long shifts and in confined spaces; requirement of some heavy lifting; work overtime when required; work independently and as a team member.
