Dr. Ruth Martin-Misener is a Professor and the Director of the School of Nursing and Assistant Dean, Research, Faculty of Health at Dalhousie University. She is also an

- Co-Director of the Canadian Center for Advanced Practice Nursing Research (CCAPNR) at McMaster University
- Editor-in-Chief for the Canadian Journal of Nursing Leadership and Associate Editor for JBI Evidence Synthesis
- Recently elected Board Member of the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing

The main focus of her research and knowledge mobilization is the implementation, optimization and outcomes of nurse practitioner and registered nurse roles and team-based models of care. The results of her research have been used to inform policy related to nurse practitioner and registered nurse scope of practice, education, regulation and deployment across sectors and populations. Several of her published articles have been cited in influential international and national policy documents. For her contributions she was inducted as a Fellow into the American Academy of Nursing in 2019 and named a Charter Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Nursing in 2020.
