

Welcome to Nova Scotia, the province that once had the highest number of traditional lighthouses that are fast disappearing as aids to navigation – 265 in 1929, now only 82 active aids!



You can travel **by car\*** to the lighthouses shown on this map by entering their civic address or name of their park on Google Maps to get driving directions from your current position. Once there, it may be necessary to park your car and walk a short distance to view them. Please do so in a safe and responsible manner to protect yourself and other drivers.

\*Not all lighthouse sites can accommodate buses, motorhomes or trailers. Please check road access to the lighthouse at the nearest Visitor Information Centre if you are driving a long vehicle.

Be aware that a significant number of lighthouses are now owned by Nova Scotia community groups who open their local lighthouse to the public during the months of July and August while a few open as soon as the Victoria Day weekend in May and close as late as the Canadian Thanksgiving weekend in October. You may see other lighthouses that are not on this map as Nova Scotia has many island lighthouses that can only be seen from shore on a clear day, or lighthouses on land that are not legally or safely accessible.
