

Guidelines for Support Material – Theatre (Directing)

Who may apply?

	Applicants who demonstrate the commitment to pursue a career in directing and who are not yet established in their field.
Writte	n support material:

Artist statement (max. 500 words).
Budget, as directed in the online application.
Artist résumé, with special focus on your directing credits (PDF format).
An analysis of how you would direct a particular play. Choose one from the theatre canon that
has been previously produced and is not too obscure (PDF format, 1000 words maximum).
Letter of intent (this could be a separate PDF or included as part of your artist statement in the
online application form) detailing:

- the reason for this particular program of study
- what you hope to accomplish
- your strengths/weaknesses as a director
- future plans (if known)
- ☐ Optional: One reference letter from someone who has insight into your specific abilities as a director (PDF format).
- ☐ Attached files should be no more than 32 MB. If you have difficulty uploading your file, create separate files, no larger than 8 MB each.

By following these quidelines, you will ensure you provide submissions that clearly demonstrate ability and potential, and relate directly to the program proposed in the application.
