

Guidelines for Support Material – Interdisciplinary Design



Who may apply?

- ☐ Applicants who demonstrate the commitment to pursue a career in interdisciplinary and industry-based technical arts and who are not yet established in their field.

Written support material: PDF format

- ☐ Artist statement (max. 500 words).
- ☐ Budget, as directed in the online application.
- ☐ Artist résumé (usually one page long, in PDF format).
- ☐ Index (PDF format) listing the order and length of all video selections.

Applicants wishing to apply for scholarships to support study programs in Interdisciplinary, Product Design, and Arts and Design are also required to supply support material. **Please contact the NSTT's Scholarship Program Coordinator** at scholarship@nstalenttrust.ns.ca to find out what support materials are required for submission.

By following these guidelines, you will ensure you provide submissions that clearly demonstrate ability and potential, and relate directly to the program proposed in the application.
