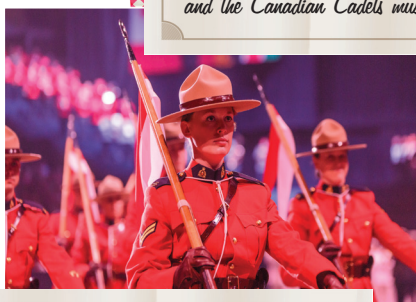
INTRODUCING THE CAST OF THE 2017 TATTOO!

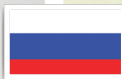

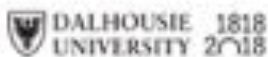
