Local rep elections

- Every school should be electing new reps as soon as possible. Ideally by September 4th. I emailed administrators letting them know and giving them a heads up re. meeting dates. Schools with:-less than 25 site based (home school) NSTU members are entitled to one union rep and one alternate; between 25-50 site based NSTU members are entitled to two union reps and two alternates; over 50 site-based NSTU members are entitled to three union reps and three alternates; over 100 site-based NSTU members are entitled to four union reps and four alternates.
