Become an NSTU Representative at Your School

NSTU Reps help keep members informed, connected and heard.

You don't need to know everything about the NSTU - you need to listen, share information and connect colleagues with the right support.

KEEP MEMBERS INFORMED

Share important NSTU news, events, deadlines, benefits and opportunities. Give brief NSTU updates at staff meetings and help keep your site's NSTU information visible.

CONNECT MEMBERS WITH SUPPORT

You are not expected to have all the answers. Help members connect with the appropriate Local or NSTU staff when questions require specialized advice.

KEEP YOUR SITE CONNECTED

Assist with the annual Member Registry, help members update their information, and work with Local leadership to arrange school visits when helpful.

BE YOUR SCHOOL'S VOICE

Listen to members' questions, ideas and concerns and bring them forward at Halifax City Local meetings through Reps' Forum. Organize site discussions when needed.

HELP MEMBERS PARTICIPATE

Help facilitate Local and Provincial NSTU votes, encourage involvement, and make sure colleagues know about opportunities available through their union.

BUILD UNION CONNECTIONS

Encourage new members to get involved and help strengthen communication between your school, Halifax City Local and the NSTU.
