Opening an account

Opening an NSTU account is automated. By following the link below and entering the necessary information you can open an account. Please be advised that you must be entered in the Membership Registry in order to open an account and you cannot open more than one account. Once an account has been activated in the system will not process a second account for you.

The system will allow you to select your own username and request that you assign a password to your account. You should note the policies relevant to usernames and passwords before you follow the link to process an account request:

Username Policy

- Username must contain only alphanumeric characters (a-z, 0-9)
- Username must be at least 8 characters long
