

IT'S IN OUR AGREEMENT

Teacher Provincial Agreement (TPA): [TPA Link Article 39 Deferred Salary Leave](#)

A deferred salary leave plan is a program that lets a teacher take an extended paid leave by setting aside a portion of their salary in advance.

- You work for several years at a slightly reduced salary.
- The amount that's "held back" is saved for you.
- After the agreed-upon period, you take a leave from work.
- During that leave, you receive the salary that was deferred — so you still have income while you're away.
