

1.05 DUTIES OF THE FIRST VICE-PRESIDENT – ECONOMIC WELFARE AND RESOLUTIONS

The First Vice-President – Economic Welfare and Resolutions shall:

- i. chair the Local's Economic Welfare and Resolutions Committee;
- ii. liaise with the NSTU Provincial Member Economic Welfare, Health and Safety, and Working Conditions and Resolutions Committees;
- iii. assume the duties of Local President when required in the President's absence;
- iv. be a member of the Halifax Regional Representative Council (HRRC) and Committees of the HRRC as assigned by the HRRC;
- v. collect and collate items from the Local for future Provincial and Regional Asking Packages;
- vi. coordinate the collection of concerns from members no later than the conclusion of the October General Meeting;
- vii. oversee, in consultation with the Local's Economic Welfare and Resolutions Committee, the collection and submission process for the Halifax County Local Resolutions to Annual Council including – submitting all necessary documentation to NSTU Central Office by the stated deadlines, reporting the disposition of Halifax County Local Resolutions to the membership, and briefing the Local's delegation to Annual Council; and,
- viii. coordinate and oversee, in consultation with the Vice-President – Nominating, the Local's Pre-Council meeting.
