

3.05 ECONOMIC WELFARE AND RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

- i. Composition:
The Economic Welfare and Resolutions Committee shall consist of 5 members (not including the Local President who should exercise ex-officio whenever reasonable possible) plus the Committee Chair.
- ii. Duties:
The duties of the Economic Welfare and Resolutions Committee shall include:
 - a. regularly attending Committee meetings and performing duties as required;
 - b. coordinating with and supporting the work of the Regional Economic Welfare Committee;
 - c. promoting effective working conditions of the Local membership;
 - d. assisting the Chair in surveying the membership regarding general concerns, collating the information and making recommendations to the Local Executive for appropriate action;
 - e. assisting the Chair in the collection and submission process of the Halifax County Local Resolutions to Annual Council; and,
 - f. helping educate and assisting members in the preparation of resolutions and accompanying briefs.
- iii. Frequency of Meetings:
It is anticipated that the Committee should be able to complete their work in four (4) meetings per year.
