KNOW YOUR CONTRACT(S)

Teachers' Provincial Agreement (TPA) Article 25 SCHOOL YEAR

25.05 - (i) up to two (2) days per teacher per year for organization purposes;

(ia) two hundred forty (240) minutes for organization purposes of the school year shall be uninterrupted time (not necessarily consecutive) allocated for professional duties as determined by the teacher prior to the first instructional day for students.
