- 1. Received Reports from the Table Officers, Personnel and Nominating Committees
- 2. Appointed the Board of Directors for the Teachers' Pension Plan Inc.
- 3. Granted permanent status to Ms. Sharon Gibson, NSTU Member Counsellor, effective September 1, 2005
- 4. Appointed the Substitute Teacher Committee for 2005-2006
- 5. Approved a comprehensive review take place in the early Fall of 2006 with the NSTU Presidential Election process; and approved a revision to the current Operational Procedures referencing the "All Candidates' Meetings" not commence any earlier than ten weeks prior to voting day, beginning with the upcoming Presidential election of 2006.
- 6. Referred a motion to the Finance & Property Committee to reconsider the inclusion of Out-of-Province and Full Time Study Grants in the upcoming budget.
- 7. Approved a proposal from the Public Affairs Committee on the administering of hospitality suites at political annual general meetings.
