PINK SHIRT DAY

This year, Pink Shirt Day, or Anti-Bullying Day, is on February 24. It is a day when people come together by wearing pink shirts to school or work to show they are against bullying. The focus for 2021 is "lift each other up."

How did Pink Shirt Day begin?

In 2007 in Nova Scotia, Grade 12 students David Shepherd, Travis Price and a few friends saw that a Grade 9 student was being bullied for wearing a pink shirt on the first day of school. They knew they had to do something to show that this kind of behaviour was not OK. They decided to go out and buy a bunch of pink shirts and hand them out to other students to wear. By the end of that week, most of the students in the school were wearing pink shirts to show support for the Grade 9 student who was bullied. Pink Shirt Day has now spread and become a national day of anti-bullying across Canada and other countries around the world!

Here's what you can do:

- Proudly wear your pink shirts to show that you stand up against bullying!
- If you see someone being bullied or you're being bullied, talk to a trusted grownup about it.
- When someone is being bullied, in person or online, stand up for them so that they know that they don't deserve to be bullied.
- Don't encourage bullying by participating in bullying behaviour.

Wearing a pink shirt on Pink Shirt Day is a great way to show you are against bullying but it's important that we all stand up against any kind of bullying every day, all year long!

Wear a pink shirt on Wednesday February 24 to show your support against anti-bullying!

HEART BUDDIES

Materials

- Washable paint, markers or crayons
- Paintbrushes (if using paint)
- Single hole punch
- Pipe cleaners (2 per Heart Buddy)
- Wiggly eyes (25 mm) or sticker eyes
- Black marker
- Craft glue
- Scissors
- White cardstock

Instructions

1. Draw heart shapes on the cardstock.
2. Paint or color the heart shapes.
3. Cut out the heart shapes.
4. Punch out 2 holes for arms and 2 holes for legs with the single hole punch. String 1 pipe cleaner through the armholes and 1 pipe cleaner through the leg holes.
5. Decorate the heart buddy by gluing eyes to it and drawing a mouth on it with a black marker.
