



ZSP COVID-19 Arena Guidelines

(Phase 4 - July 14, 2021)

The safety and health of our staff and customers are of the utmost importance. Be assured that we have been closely following the recommendations of Public Health. To help stop the spread of COVID-19 we have implemented several new measures for the arena.

All participants must follow the [Provincial Public Health Guidelines](#). Participants must also abide by the regulations of their respective sport governing body. **Participants not following these regulations will be at risk of losing their ice time for the entire group, including future rentals.**

These are additional conditions to the standard Sportsplex rental contract.

ENTERING THE FACILITY

All participants are required to check in at the Welcome Desk when entering through the main entrance. Please provide the group name that the rental is listed under.

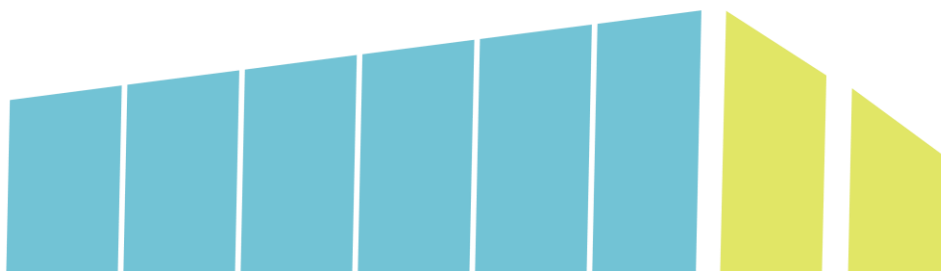
Spectators are now permitted. Please refer to the COVID-19 Arena Spectator Guidelines for spectator information and requirements.

Participants will be allowed to enter the building 15 minutes prior to the start of their rental and must leave no later than 15 minutes after their rental. Extra time is needed between each rental for staff to disinfect the area and prevent interaction between rental groups.

We kindly ask that groups meet outside the building first and enter as a group.

Participants who are 12 years of age and younger can be accompanied by one guardian if needed. The guardian is **not** permitted to stay in the facility while the participant is on the ice, unless they are in a group rental that includes the parent or guardian.

We ask that participants come dressed in their equipment and leave dressed in their equipment as much as possible (excluding skates, helmets, gloves, and goalie pads). We understand that in certain cases or scenarios, this may not be completely feasible. Participants have access to the dressing rooms 15 minutes before and after their rental. If you can get dressed or finish getting dressed in the 15-minute allotted time, that is permitted. If participants are not dressed on time for their ice rental, no additional ice time will be added.



For contact tracing purposes, each rental group is required to have a list of participants with their contact information for each ice time. If contact tracing is required, it will be the responsibility of the organizer to communicate with their members and provide information to public health.

Masks are required to enter the facility.

- You must be wearing a mask when you enter the Sportsplex. If you are not wearing one, you will not be allowed to enter.
- Only medical and non-medical facemasks will be accepted at the Sportsplex. Bandanas, neck gaiters, balaclavas, clear plastic mouth shields, or items of clothing tied around the face will **not** be accepted. Face shields do not replace facemasks.
- You can take your mask off after you have entered your dressing room.
- Masks are not required to be worn while you are on the ice.
- After your rental is complete, you must put your mask on in the dressing room before you leave and wear it until you have left the building.
- Masks must be worn whenever you are leaving your rental area (in the washroom, in hallways, etc.)
- People with medical conditions that restrict them from wearing a mask are exempt.

FACILITY RESTRICTIONS

Please follow all directional signage as posted.

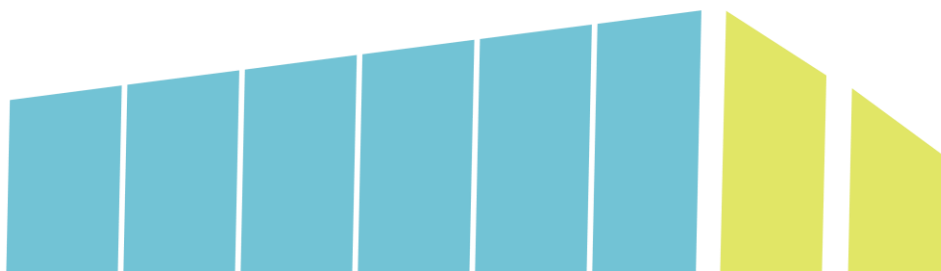
Dressing room assignments are clearly posted at the beginning of the hallway and outside each room. Please ensure that your group is using the correct room(s).

Please remain in your assigned dressing room(s) until the start of your ice time.

Showers are available in each team room.

Spitting is not permitted anywhere in the facility.

There is a maximum of 25 people allowed in an organized sports group indoors without social distancing. This includes all players, goalies, coaches, instructors' referees, and timekeepers. Games are now permitted. Tournaments are permitted if they're run by or affiliated with a provincial sport organization and follow their Return to Sport Plan. Unorganized or casual games, that are more social in nature, like pickup games or skating parties, are allowed a maximum of 25 people for each rental.





The sharing of water bottles and equipment is prohibited. Water bottles must be filled at home and labeled with your name.

While on the ice, participants including coaches, must keep their helmets and gloves on.

To exit the building, please use the stairs located by the dressing rooms. This will lead you to the exit for our parking lot. Any participants requiring the use of the elevator will exit through the main entrance.

Participants must abide by the regulations of their respective sport governing body. All rules in place by sport governing bodies are subject to review by the Zatzman Sportsplex.
