Application to Theatre Nova Scotia for ad hoc membership must be made by an ad hoc group eight (8) weeks in advance of the first scheduled performance of the production they wish to be juried.

Separate online submissions for Merritt Awards consideration must also be made at least six (6) weeks in advance of the first scheduled performance of the production to be juried.
