The Robert Merritt Awards have been recognizing excellence in Nova Scotia theatre since 2002. Each year, a volunteer jury of theatre professionals attend professional theatre productions that have been nominated for awards consideration across Nova Scotia. This creates an opportunity for our members to survey the wide landscape of our provincial theatre scene and to witness the many adventures theatre professionals embark on through their chosen type of performance.

Jurors must be individual members in good standing of TNS and applications are encouraged from professional theatre practitioners from diverse backgrounds, career stages, and areas of theatre practice.

Jurors are responsible for seeing all eligible professional productions in Nova Scotia from January to December 2022. The number of productions in a year ranges from 35-50 and Jurors will receive complimentary tickets to the performances.

The juror voting process will take place from late January to early March 2025 and the awards show is anticipated to take place in April, 2025

Please note this opportunity includes a significant requirement for travel; year-round to Sydney and throughout the summer months as productions take place in Halifax, Chester, Wolfville, Parrsboro, Antigonish, Baddeck, and Canning throughout July and August. TNS will offset any necessary travel costs as Jurors must arrange their own travel.
