Use the photocopier and printer at the TNS office in Halifax to produce high quality scripts, posters, brochures, programs and more in greyscale or full colour at discounted rates. Call ahead to make sure we are in the office, then bring your documents in PDF format on a USB drive. Bring your own specialized paper, or use ours. We have letter, legal and 11x17" sizes. You can now produce pre-stapled half fold documents automatically. Feel free to use our stapler, three hole punch and paper cutter while you're here at no extra charge.

The Robert Merritt Awards

All Professional Theatre members are eligible for the Robert Merritt Awards. However, the Merritt Awards jury does not automatically see each production by our Professional Theatre Members. The Wes Daniels Design Award honors the artistic spirit of the late props builder and set designer Wes Daniels, a long-time employee of Neptune Theatre and a gifted artist. The annual award will provide a matching financial gift of up to \$1,000 annually to a theatre company to subsidize, for a given production, the hiring of an emerging theatre professional who has demonstrated a strong artistic sensibility in the field of theatre design.
