A&M will put an announcement in the bulletin and or newsletter to let everyone know this has happened. Canadian Wage subsidy has helped us this year in the amountof \$40,737 but that is over now. Revenues are bit behind, general operating expenses are almost \$50,000 less than budgeted. Suggestion of scheduling another meeting in December to discuss the 2022 Budget as we need to have council approval of budget for 2022 by end of December or very early January 2022. Let committees know to get their budget numbers into Ivan as soon as possible.

**ROUND TABLE:** Jerry is encouraging Council to look at the final accessibility project with the idea of updating the chancel to make it accessible and more viable for concerts and services. A few members have visited a couple of churches in Truro to see what they have done with renovations.

Brian suggested that we see about making Woodlawn buildings a 'Comfort Area'. Has to be on agovernment approved list. Brian will follow up with the Outreach Team on this.
