**NOTES FROM THE EAST DARTMOUTH CHRISTIAN FOOD BANK** *Thank*

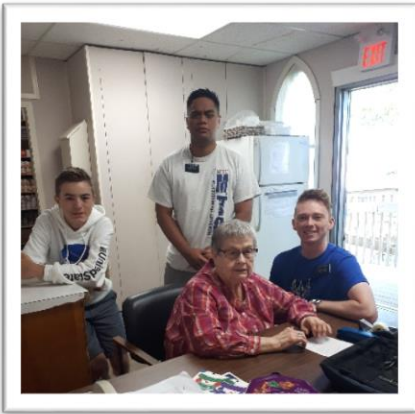


*you for the generous donations of school supplies! We know that the families we support are extremely grateful, and the kids wouldn't have all these nice things without your help. We thank you on their*
